

Scholarship Application



The Hunter Spouses Club Scholarship Program will award scholarships to deserving students (HSC member or his/her spouse/child) to further their education. We are looking for well-rounded students. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, citizenship, extra-curricular activities, letters of recommendation, and an essay.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Active HSC member, or their spouse or child.
2. Must be accepted to an accredited College, University or Vocational-Technical School as one of the following:
 - a. Graduating High School student enrolling as a full-time student.
 - b. Enrolling as a part-time or full-time student with at least one full year left before graduation. For undergraduate studies only.
 - c. Working toward certification (i.e., vo-tech) during 2010-2011 year.
3. Not in receipt of any appointment to any Service Academy, or any other full Scholarship Program (ROTC, Athletic, etc.).

All application information must be postdated by **20 March 2010**.

Letter will notify winners by **25 April 2010**.

Presentation will be at HSC Luncheon **11 May 2010**.

Upon receipt of registration notification from the appropriate school, a check will be sent to the school by September 1st, 2010.

A sealed, official record (transcript) of your academic progress and the record of academic work form are required. If you have more than one year of college but less than two years, please submit a high school transcript. Have your counselor complete the enclosed form and highlight honors classes. It is your responsibility to ensure transcripts/forms are received as requested.

Other documents:

- Please include a copy of your valid **military ID card** (front and back)
- Include a copy of your ACT/SAT scores
